

# Zimbabwe Safari Checklist

## Camping

- Sleeping bag
- Flash light
- Raincoat
- Tent
- Camping chairs

## Clothing

- Sunhat or other wide brimmed hat (also available locally)
- Swimming costume
- 1 pair of good walking/hiking shoes
- 1 pair of sandals/flip flops
- Underwear and socks
- T-shirts and long sleeved shirts
- Pairs of jeans/trousers
- Shorts or skirts (Summer)
- Warm jacket (Winter)
- Sweater (Winter)
- Elegant/Casual outfit for cocktails or dinners (if applicable)

## Documents

- Passport
- Visa (if applicable)
- Yellow Fever Certificate (if applicable)
- Bus or Air Ticket
- Cash (\$, £, € accepted) and credit cards
- Travel itineraries, accommodation booking documents and activities vouchers
- Emergency contact information

## Driving

- Drivers' License
- Vehicle Registration documents
- Temporary exportation document from the country where the vehicle is registered
- Temporary Import permit (T.I.P. - which you will get at the border)
- Pay Carbon Tax (through ZIMRA at the border, fee depends on the size of the vehicle, up to US\$30)
- Pay Road access fee (through Zimbabwe National Road Authority at the border, up to US\$10)
- Cash for toll gates (see locations [here](#))
- 4x4s pay for a CVG (Commercial Vehicle Guarantee), around US\$ 50
- Vehicle accessories ([click here](#))
- Extra fuel
- At least 5 litres of water per person
- Toilet paper

## Electronics

- Camera and accessories (lots of extra storage)
- Extra batteries
- Binoculars
- Cell phone

## Health

- Malaria Pills
- Sunscreen
- UV Sunglasses
- Multi vitamins
- Insect repellent (also available locally)
- Band aids (also available locally)
- Antiseptic and antibiotic cream/toilettes
- Any prescription medication that you might need

## Riding the bus

- Small blanket
- Pillow or neck pillow
- Plastic bag for trash
- Bottled water and non-perishable foods
- Reading material, games, puzzles and/or music
- Toilet paper
- Ear plugs to help you sleep

## Toiletries

- Soap
- Shampoo
- Deodorant
- Comb/Brush
- Q-Tips
- Fingernail Clippers
- Towel
- Toothbrush & Paste
- Lotions/Skin Creams
- Shaving Kit
- Contact Lens Preparation (if applicable)
- Toilet paper

## Miscellaneous

- Ziplock bags for electronics
- Padlock and keys
- Watch
- Voltage converter and Square pin plug adapter - 220 volts (if applicable)
- Pens
- Plastic bag for dirty clothes
- Journal
